Nick kicked off the semester by starting a 5 week study that examines the main themes of the book of Joshua. We're doing this study during Lent and building to Easter, with a call to students to invite their friends and roommates to come learn about Jesus and hear the Gospel in small groups and on Sundays. As the semester begins we also begin planning and preparing for Spring Break. This year we'll be returning to Memphis, TN to work with Service Over Self doing home repair for those in need. This is always an impactful and challenging trip for our students as they encounter and serve those in a much different economic situation and life circumstance.
